**** BANDED ON THE TOP WITH A **DOUBLE** TWIST OF THE RUBBER BAND AND AS CLOSE TO THE **** BOTTOM OF THE STAFFS WITH A **TRIPLE** TWIST OF THE RUBBER BAND.

AFTER YOU HAVE PUT THE TOP RUBBER BAND ON THE BUNDLE, GENTLY RACHET THE STAFFS TO TRY AND STRAIGHTEN THEM OUT THEN PUT THE BOTTOM RUBBER BAND ON.

GENTLY TAP DOWN ON THE STAFF END AFTER BANDING TO TRY AND EVEN OUT THE STAFF LENGTHS TO BETTER FIT INTO THE TOTES.

ALL FLAGS SHOULD GO BACK INTO THE BLACK TOTES. DO NOT WORRY ABOUT HOW MANY THE TOTE CALLS FOR OR THE SECTION NUMBER ON THE TOTE. PUT 500 - 540 FLAGS IN EACH TOTE.

PLACE ANY BROKEN OR DAMAGED STAFFS OR FLAGS INTO A SEPARATE TOTE ALONG WITH ANY EXTRA RUBBER BANDS.
